



2009 SNOW REMOVAL

Order of Snow Removal

- Crews will plow streets to open for passage during snowfall
- Curb-to-curb plowing will occur as soon as possible. This can be up to 24 hours after the snowfall has ended.

Street clearing priorities are:

- Main streets and thoroughfares so that emergency vehicles can travel to any area of the City
- Subdivision streets
- Alleys and cul-de-sacs (may be a single pass at first)
- Push back at intersections

How Can Residents Help?

- When two or more inches of snow has fallen, vehicles may not be parked on the street until streets have been cleared from curb to curb.
- When you clear your driveway, pile snow to the down street side.
- Dig out fire hydrants and storm drains after a snow.



Safety Tips

- Stay at least 100 feet behind snowplows.
- When plowing, salting or spreading brine solution, City vehicles make sudden stops and turns and may back-up at intersections.
