MONTGOMERY COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE REGIONAL DISPATCH CENTER

The Montgomery County Regional Dispatch Center is scheduled for an on-site assessment as part of a program to achieve accreditation by verifying our professional standards. The Public Safety Communications Accreditation Program (PSCAP) is administered by the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc. The program requires agencies to comply with state of the art standards in four basic areas: policy and procedures, administration, operations, and support services.

As a part of the on-site assessment, employees of the Regional Dispatch Center, members of the community and law enforcement agencies are invited to offer comments by calling (937) 384-2452 on Monday, August 16, 2010, between 1:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. The Assessment Team will be taking telephone comments during those hours.

Telephone comments are limited to five minutes and must address the ability of the Regional Dispatch Center to comply with the Commission's standards.
