## RESOLUTION NO. R - 10 - 15 - 69

### A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT A JOINT APPLICATION WITH THE CITY OF TROTWOOD, OHIO TO THE MIAMI VALLEY REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION (MVRPC) FOR SURFACE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM (STP) GRANT FUNDS

**WHEREAS**, the MVRPC is currently soliciting from communities applications for STP grant funds available in State Fiscal Year 2017; and


**WHEREAS**, if awarded the STP grant, the City of Trotwood has pledged \$60,000.00 and the City of Clayton has pledged \$83,000.00 for the necessary matching grant funds and City staff has recommended the City of Clayton submit a joint application with the City of Trotwood to the MVRPC in a cooperative endeavor to receive an award of STP grant funds from MVRPC for State Fiscal Year 2017 and if awarded, to be used to resurface a 3 mile section of Westbrook Road which would benefit both communities.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLAYTON, STATE OF OHIO:**

1. That the Council of the City of Clayton, Ohio hereby authorizes the City Manager to submit a joint application with the City of Trotwood, Ohio to the MVRPC and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance for an STP grant for funds available in State Fiscal Year 2017. If awarded, said funds would be used to resurface a 3 mile section of Westbrook Road which would benefit both communities.
2. The City of Clayton, Ohio does agree to obligate its portion of the STP grant matching funds necessary as described herein.
3. The City of Clayton is requesting an exemption to MVRPC's Complete Streets Policy since the project for which the City is requesting funds is a resurfacing project only.
