RESOLUTION NO. R – 10 – 15 - 74

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH ANTHEM BLUE CROSS BLUE SHIELD FOR THE PROVISION OF GROUP HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFITS FROM DECEMBER 1, 2015 THROUGH OCTOBER 1, 2016

WHEREAS, the City's current group health insurance contract is due to expire on December 1, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Brower Insurance Agency, LLC which serves as the City's broker for group health insurance, has received proposals from insurance providers for multiple plan designs of the City's group health insurance benefits; and


WHEREAS, City staff has reviewed the proposals received and determined the most favorable proposal is from the City's current provider, Anthem Blue Cross/Blue Shield and recommends renewal of the current Anthem Blue Cross/Blue Shield Plan for the period December 1, 2015 through October 1, 2016.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLAYTON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to accept the proposal of and enter into an agreement with Anthem Blue Cross Blue Shield for the provision of group health insurance benefits in the form of a Health Savings Account (HSA) from December 1, 2015 through October 1, 2016 .
2. That this Resolution shall be effective as an exception to any ordinance, resolution or other legislation of the City of Clayton, Ohio, inconsistent with this Resolution or which imposes additional requirements for effectiveness or validity.




