RESOLUTION NO. R – 02 – 16 - 18

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO WRITTEN CHANGE ORDERS NOT TO EXCEED \$25,000.00 PER PROJECT WITH CONTRACTORS OF THE CITY FOR THE PERFORMANCE OF SPECIFIED WORK

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City of Clayton to enter into contracts for the performance of certain provision of goods and related services, including but not limited to, construction contracts for the benefit of the City and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, during the performance of contracted duties on behalf of the City and pursuant to contract, a contractor at times encounters unforeseen issues with such things as utilities, soft soils and drainage issues which need to be immediately addressed so as not to hinder or slow the contractor's duties and to minimize delay in performance of the contract; and

WHEREAS, City Council desires to authorize the City Manager to enter into written change orders with contractors of the City in order to address unforeseen issues which occur during performance of contracts so as to minimize work stoppages and delays.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLAYTON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into change orders with contractors of the City in order to address unforeseen issues which occur during performance of the contract so as to minimize work stoppages and delays. All such change orders shall be in writing and the total amount of said change orders shall not exceed \$25,000.00 per project.
2. That this Resolution shall be effective as an exception to any ordinance, resolution or other legislation of the City of Clayton, Ohio, inconsistent with this Resolution or which imposes additional requirements for effectiveness or validity.
