RESOLUTION NO. R – 12 – 17 - 65

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A RENEWAL AGREEMENT WITH ANTHEM BLUE CROSS BLUE SHIELD FOR THE PROVISION OF GROUP HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFITS FROM JANUARY 1, 2018 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2018

WHEREAS, Anthem Blue Cross Blue Shield has proposed an opportunity for renewal of the agreement to provide group health insurance benefits without any plan changes for the year 2018; and

WHEREAS, working with the City's insurance broker, health insurance quotes were received from several potential carriers; and

WHEREAS, renewal of the current Anthem policy permits continuation of the contract plan at the best and lowest price reasonably possible maintaining the same benefit level; and


WHEREAS, City Staff and the Employee Health Insurance Committee has reviewed the information provided by the City's insurance broker and recommends renewal with Anthem.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLAYTON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to accept the proposal of and enter into a renewal agreement with Anthem Blue Cross Blue Shield for the provision of group health insurance benefits from January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018.
2. That this Resolution shall be effective as an exception to any ordinance, resolution or other legislation of the City of Clayton, Ohio, inconsistent with this Resolution or which imposes additional requirements for effectiveness or validity.


