Dear Valued Customer,

DP&L values you as a customer and makes every effort to keep you informed of changes that may affect your property. We are writing to share the improvements The Dayton Power and Light Company ("DP&L") is making to an overhead electric transmission line that crosses your property. The transmission line is a 69kV line connecting DP&L's Salem, Englewood, and West Milton substations in Montgomery and Miami County.

The improvements will consist of replacing the electric wires and all the steel towers, many of which are more than 85 years old. This project is being undertaken to comply with mandatory Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) reliability requirements. The improvements will strengthen the electric system and will improve reliability by reducing the number of outages that would otherwise affect our customers.

To rebuild the existing transmission line and maintain reliability, vegetation clearing, and trimming may be necessary. Additionally, for safe construction and maintenance access, on some properties there may need to be a relocation of facilities like storage sheds away from DP&L's electric transmission line. Some fences may also need to be temporarily moved during the rebuild. To aid in this work, a survey crew will be marking the edge of DP&L's right of way with wooden stakes. In the coming weeks, Jeannine Myers from Commonwealth Associates, a contractor working on DP&L's behalf, will contact you to discuss the specifics for any work needed on your property.

Actual construction for the project is scheduled to begin in September 2019. You will be contacted regarding the schedule when work on your property will take place. Customers should not see any interruption to their electric service because of this work. Rest assured, repairs will be made to any customer property damage that may occur. We understand the construction project will present a temporary inconvenience as we work to strengthen our infrastructure to provide safe, reliable electric service.
