RESOLUTION NO. R – 03 – 21 – 18

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING CHRISTINE BACHMAN AS A MEMBER OF THE LOCAL BOARD OF TAX REVIEW

WHEREAS, Clayton Codified Ordinance Section 183.18 provides for the establishment and maintenance of a Local Board of Tax Review to hear appeals as provided in Ohio Revised Code Chapter 718; and

WHEREAS, Clayton Codified Ordinance Section 183.18 requires the legislative authority of the City of Clayton to appoint two members to the Local Board of Tax Review who must be domiciled within the City of Clayton and may not be employees, elected officials, or contractors with the City of Clayton at any time during their term or in the five years immediately preceding the date of appointment; and

WHEREAS, the term of Tom Walker on the Tax Review Board expires March 7, 2021 and Council desires to appoint Christine Bachman as a member of the Local Board of Tax Review to fill the vacant seat.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLAYTON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. That Christine Bachman is hereby appointed to the Local Board of Tax Review for a 2-year term commencing March 8, 2021 and ending March 7, 2023.

**A RESOLUTION APPOINTING KRIS ROLL TO THE
PARKS ADVISORY COMMISSION**

WHEREAS, Clayton Codified Ordinance Chapter 159 created the Parks Advisory Commission; and

WHEREAS, Clayton Codified Ordinance Chapter 159 provides for the appointment of nine (9) members to the Parks Advisory Commission to be appointed by a majority vote of Council for overlapping terms of three years each; and

WHEREAS, with the appointment of Sabrina Pritchett to the Planning Commission a vacant seat on the Parks Advisory Commission exists and Council desires to appoint Kris Roll to fill said vacant seat.

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING A NEW COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT
WITH THE OHIO PATROLMENS BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION SETTING FORTH
THE WAGES, BENEFITS AND TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT FOR
PATROL OFFICERS WITHIN THE CLAYTON POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR THE
PERIOD JANUARY 1, 2021 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2023**

WHEREAS, representatives of the City and Union have tentatively agreed upon a successor Collective Bargaining Agreement for the patrol officers within the Clayton Police Department and staff has recommended it for approval; and

WHEREAS, said Agreement provides for a wage increase of 2.0% in year one, 2.0% in year two, and 2.0% in year three; and

WHEREAS, said Agreement maintains the City of Clayton in a comparable position on wages and benefits relative to surrounding departments within the Miami Valley.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLAYTON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. That the Collective Bargaining Agreement with the OPBA for the period 1/1/21-12/31/23 appended hereto as *Exhibit A* and made a part hereof is approved and the City Manager is authorized to execute said Agreement on behalf of the City.
