A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AND PROCLAIMING THE NAME OF THE PROPOSED MULTI-USE RECREATIONAL PATH

WHEREAS, the City of Clayton has proposed to construct a Multi-Use Recreational Path on property located along National Road spanning from Hoke Road and traveling in a westerly direction to the Northmont Middle School property; and

WHEREAS, the City of Clayton wants to encourage physical activity and recreation opportunities for residents; and

WHEREAS, National Road, also known as U.S. Route 40, holds a significant place in the history of Ohio and the nation; and

WHEREAS, National Road is the country's first federally funded interstate road and has been recognized as one of the nation's elite byways for its historic, cultural and scenic characteristics; and


WHEREAS, the City of Clayton is interested in celebrating and preserving this great piece of history by naming the Multi-Use Recreational Path and incorporating educational elements of National Road into the path.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLAYTON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. That the Council of the City of Clayton hereby establishes and proclaims the name of the proposed Multi-Use Recreational Path to be National Road Trail.


