A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO EXERCISE CONTRACTUAL OPTION AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH JOHN R. JURGENSEN COMPANY FOR 2014 STREET RESURFACING AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$513,001.00

WHEREAS, via enactment of Resolution No. R-06-13-33 on June 20, 2013, Council authorized the City Manager to accept the bid submitted by and enter into a contract for the 2013 street resurfacing project with John R. Jurgensen Company for an amount not to exceed \$468,898.37; and

WHEREAS, on or about July 8, 2013, the City entered into a Street Overlay Contract with John R. Jurgensen Company for street resurfacing and said Contract contains a provision in Section 4 thereof allowing the City to exercise an option to engage John R. Jurgensen Company for street overlay services for the year 2014 at a total contract amount of \$513,001.00 subject to any change orders, additions and deductions as provided in the contract documents; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to exercise the Contract option with John R. Jurgensen Company for street overlay services for the year 2014 at a total contract amount of \$513,001.00 subject to any change orders, additions and deductions as provided in the contract documents.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLAYTON, STATE OF OHIO:


