A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH BALSBAUGH EXCAVATING, INC. FOR REPLACEMENT OF NINE CATCH BASINS ON MAIN STREET AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$22,365.00

WHEREAS, Charter Section 8.02(C)(1) exempts purchases under a threshold amount from competitive bidding and via the enactment of Ordinance No. O-09-14-07 on October 2, 2014 that threshold amount was increased to \$25,920.00; and


WHEREAS, nine catch basin drains on Main Street are in need of replacement and City Staff has received two quotes and Balsbaugh Excavating, Inc. is the lower of the two bids and City Staff recommends entering into an agreement with Balsbaugh Excavating, Inc. for an amount not to exceed \$22,365.00 for replacement of the nine catch basin drains.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLAYTON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. That the City Manager is authorized to enter into an agreement with Balsbaugh Excavating, Inc. for services related to replacement of the nine catch basin drains on Main Street for an amount not to exceed \$22,365.00.


