RESOLUTION NO. R – 04 – 16 - 36

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT BID AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH ADC CONCRETE, LLC FOR 2016 PART B CONCRETE CURB AND DRIVEWAY WORK (SAVINA AREA) IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$179,635.00

WHEREAS, the Clayton City Manager solicited bids for concrete work relative to the 2016 Cubing, Catch-Basin and Drive Approach Program, said solicitation having been made in accordance with the provisions of Charter Section 8.02; and

WHEREAS, the Request For Proposal (“RFP”) issued by the City of Clayton, Ohio instructed bidders that Part B of the subject Project was to be bid and awarded as one job; and


WHEREAS, said Part B bids have been received and reviewed by the City Manager and staff and the bid submitted by ADC Concrete, LLC is recommended for acceptance as being the lowest and best, responsive bid submitted by a responsible bidder as to the 2016 Part B Concrete Curb and Driveway Work (Savina Area) in an amount not to exceed \$179,635.00.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLAYTON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. That the City Manager is authorized to accept bid and to enter into an agreement with ADC Concrete, LLC for 2016 Concrete Flat Work (Part A) as more particularly described in the subject RFP and for an amount not in excess of \$179,635.00.
2. That this Resolution shall be effective as an exception to any ordinance, resolution or other legislation of the City of Clayton, Ohio, inconsistent with this Ordinance or which imposes additional requirements for effectiveness or validity.
