Workshop Meeting of the Clayton, Ohio Council Clayton Government Center February 7, 2022

Due to the inclement weather on Thursday, February 3rd Clayton City Council rescheduled this Workshop to Monday, February 7th at 6:30 PM.

The workshop was called to order by Mayor Stevens at 6:30 PM. Present were Mayor Stevens and Council members Bachman, Gorman, Merkle, Kelly, and Lieberman. Motion by Bachman to excuse Councilman Henning who is out of town this evening from both the Workshop and regular Council meeting, motion was second by Merkle. All yeas, motion passed.

This workshop was called to discuss Council compensation. Amanda Zimmerlin, City Manager, began with a city council salary survey that was completed by the City of Kettering. It broke the salary out between the mayor and council, and also took into consideration population and per capita what each resident technically pays for their council person. It also lists the other benefits that council members may receive.

Council discussed and agreed to creating a Citizen Commission to review Counsel compensation. Law Director Dillon advised that under Charter 7.04 it allows Counsel to establish other boards and commissions that are not already established in the Charter. Legislation to create a Citizen's Commission to review Counsel compensation will be brought forth in an upcoming City Council meeting.

Motion by Gorman to close the workshop, second by Kelly. All yeas, motion passed.
