## RESOLUTION NO. R – 07 – 24 - 43

### **A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE STATE OF OHIO DIRECTOR OF TRANSPORTATION MODIFY THE SPEED LIMIT TO 35 MPH ON MAIN STREET WITHIN THE CITY OF CLAYTON, OHIO FROM GREENVIEW DRIVE AT SLM 20.039 TO THE END OF THE CORPORATION LIMIT AT SLM 21.028**

**WHEREAS**, residents and citizens have voiced concerns as to the posted speed limit along Main Street within the City of Clayton, Ohio from Greenview Drive to the north corporation limit at SLM 21.028, approximately 6400' ( 1.22 miles) in length; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Clayton, Ohio contracted Choice One Engineering to conduct a speed study for the above referenced portion of Main Street; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has determined the general welfare and safety of the traveling public requires the speed limit on the above-mentioned road should be modified as recommended by Choice One Engineering: *Modify speed limit to 35 MPH on Main Street within the City of Clayton, Ohio from Greenview Drive at SLM 20.039 to the end of the corporation limit at SLM 21.028.*


### **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLAYTON, STATE OF OHIO:**

1. That the State of Ohio Director of Transportation is hereby requested to modify the speed limit on the above-mentioned road as follows: *Modify speed limit to 35 MPH on Main Street within the City of Clayton, Ohio from Greenview Drive at SLM 20.039 to the end of the corporation limit at SLM 21.028.*
2. That the City of Clayton, Ohio hereby agrees, in the event the speed limit is changed on the above-mentioned road as requested to erect and maintain appropriate signs and markings.
3. That this Resolution shall take immediate effect.


