RESOLUTIONS (SINGLE READING AND IMMEDIATE ENACTMENT)

RESOLUTION NO. R – 04 – 25 – 32

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AMENDMENTS TO THE PUBLIC RECORDS REQUEST POLICY FOR THE CITY OF CLAYTON RELATIVE TO COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH LAW ENFORCEMENT DASHBOARD CAMERA VIDEOS AND/OR BODY CAMERA VIDEOS

WHEREAS, House Bill 315, which goes into effect on April 3, 2025, permits jurisdictions to charge up to \$750 for the time it takes to review, blur or otherwise obscure, redact, upload, and/or produce copies of law enforcement dashboard camera video(s) and/or body camera video(s); and

WHEREAS, the proposed amended and attached Public Records Request Policy was approved by the Records Commission on January 16, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to update the Public Records Request Policy with specified amendments thereto as delineated in the appended *Exhibit A*.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLAYTON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. That the City hereby approves and adopts the amended Public Records Request Policy for the City of Clayton appended hereto as *Exhibit A*.
2. The Clerk of Council is hereby directed to carry out all steps necessary to implement the attached Policy, including compliance with all posting requirements.

RESOLUTION NO. R – 04 – 25 – 33

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT THE BID OF AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE JOHN R. JURGENSEN COMPANY FOR THE 2025 MILL AND FILL ASPHALT PAVING PROJECT AT A TOTAL COST NOT TO EXCEED \$570,000.00

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of Charter Section 8.02, the City solicited and received two bids with respect to the 2025 Mill and Fill Asphalt Paving Project; and

WHEREAS, said bids have been received and reviewed and the City Manager and City staff recommends for acceptance the bid received from John R. Jurgensen Company as being the lowest and best bid submitted by a responsible bidder; and therefore, City staff recommends accepting said bid in accordance with the terms of the request for bids.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLAYTON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to accept the bid of and enter into an agreement with John R. Jurgensen Company for the 2025 mill and fill asphalt project with the total cost of same not to exceed \$570,000.00.

RESOLUTION NO. R – 04 – 25 – 34

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE FROM BUCKEYE POWER SALES A NEW GENERATOR TO BE USED IN THE CITY MAINTENANCE GARAGE AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$41,289.00

WHEREAS, via City Charter Section 8.02(C)(1) and enactment of Ordinance No. 12-23-27, the current minimum competitive bid threshold is \$77,398.00; and

WHEREAS, the Public Service Director has recommended purchase of a new generator to be used at the City Maintenance Garage in the event of power outage(s) to allow daily work to continue uninterrupted.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLAYTON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. That the City Manager is authorized to purchase one (1) new generator from Buckeye Power Sales for use at the City Maintenance Garage in an amount not to exceed \$41,289.00.

RESOLUTION NO. R – 04 - 25 - 36

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A WAGE AGREEMENT FOR THE YEARS 2025 AND 2026 WITH THE OHIO PATROLMEN’S BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION FOR PATROL OFFICERS WITHIN THE CLAYTON POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, representatives of the City and Union have tentatively agreed upon a Wage Agreement for the years 2025 and 2026 for the Patrol Officers within the Clayton Police Department and staff has recommended it for approval; and

WHEREAS, said Agreement provides for a 3% wage increase for the year 2025, effective January 1, 2025, and further provides for a 3% wage increase for the year 2026 plus a market adjustment of \$1.75, effective January 1, 2026; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLAYTON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. That the 2025 and 2026 wage agreement with the OPBA for the Patrol Officers for a 3% wage increase for the year 2025, effective January 1, 2025, and for a 3% wage increase for the year 2026 plus a market adjustment of \$1.75, effective January 1, 2026, (**Exhibit A**) is approved and the City Manager is authorized to execute said Agreement on behalf of the City.
