RESOLUTION NO. R – 12 – 25 – 82

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR INSPECTION OF THE HOKE ROAD WIDENING PROJECT

WHEREAS the City of Clayton (the City) has undertaken a multi-phase public improvement known as the Hoke Road Widening Project (the Project) to improve traffic flow and safety along Hoke Road; and

WHEREAS the Miami Valley Regional Planning Commission (MVRPC) has awarded grant funding to support the Project, subject to applicable grant administration and reporting requirements; and

WHEREAS the City’s staff report titled “Hoke Rd. Widening” dated [December 12, 2025] (the Staff Report) recommends: (a) for Phase 1 (Smith Road north to Wenger Road, including a roundabout), the selection of CTL Engineering, Inc. for construction engineering/inspection services, with the City responsible for twenty-one percent (21%) of the construction engineering/inspection costs, not to exceed Forty-One Thousand Two Hundred Thirty-Six Dollars (\$41,236), to be included in the City’s yearly construction budget; and

WHEREAS in connection with Phase 1, the Project is estimated to commence in or about April 2026, and

WHEREAS the City Manager, as the contracting authority for the design and inspection phases, requires formal authorization to negotiate, execute, and administer contracts for the above-described services, consistent with applicable Ohio law, ODOT standards where applicable, and MVRPC grant requirements;

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Council of the City of Clayton, Ohio, that:


1. Authorization for Phase 1 Construction Engineering/Inspection
 - 1.1. The City Manager is authorized to negotiate, execute, and deliver on behalf of the City a contract with CTL Engineering, Inc. for construction engineering/inspection services for the Hoke Road Widening Project, Phase 1 (Smith Road to Wenger Road, including the roundabout), substantially consistent with the recommendations set forth in the Staff Report.
 - 1.2. The City’s share of the cost for Phase 1 construction engineering/inspection shall be twenty-one percent (21%), in a total amount not to exceed Forty-One Thousand Two Hundred Thirty-Six Dollars (\$41,236), inclusive of all City obligations for such services, which amount shall be paid from appropriations in the City’s yearly construction budget.
