A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF PERSONAL PROTECTIVE GEAR FROM PHOENIX FIRE EQUIPMENT FOR USE BY THE FIRE DEPARTMENT AT A TOTAL COST NOT TO EXCEED \$60,000.00

WHEREAS, R.C. § 125.04 provides for the procedure whereby purchases may be made by political subdivisions without competitive bidding by participating in contracts formulated by the Ohio Department of Administrative Services; and


WHEREAS, the Fire Chief stated this is part of the fire department's PPE (personal protective equipment) replacement program where the PPE is replaced every 7-10 years depending on the condition and cost to repair the PPE. NFPA (National Fire Protection Association) states that PPE should be replaced at minimum every 10 years. The total price is below the approved bid threshold for the city. The pricing is below Ohio State bid pricing.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLAYTON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. That the City Manager is authorized to purchase personal protective gear on State Bid from Phoenix Fire Equipment for use by the Fire Department at a total price not to exceed \$60,000.00 at the State Bid Price.


