ORDINANCE NO. O - 03 - 14 - 05

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT EXTENSION AGREEMENT WITH REPUBLIC WASTE SERVICES FOR RESIDENTIAL SOLID WASTE COLLECTION

WHEREAS, the City of Clayton entered into a contract with Republic Waste Services in 2009 for a contract period of June 1, 2009 through April 30, 2014 for residential solid waste collection services; and

WHEREAS, the residential solid waste collection contract with Republic Waste Services provides for the option to renew the agreement for up to 5 years; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to renew the residential solid waste collection contract with Republic Waste Services through April 30, 2019 with the following rate increase schedule:

2014: 0%
2015: 1%
2016: 1%
2017: 2%
2018: 1.5%; and


WHEREAS, Republic Waste Services will also increase its contribution to the City Newsletter by \$500.00 and provide a port-o-let for Westbrook Park from April 1 through October 31 every year for the duration of the contract.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLAYTON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. That the City Manager is authorized to enter into a renewal agreement with Republic Waste Services for residential solid waste collection through April 30, 2019 and on substantially the same terms provided herein.
2. That this Ordinance shall be effective as an exception to any ordinance, resolution or other legislation of the City of Clayton, Ohio, inconsistent with this Ordinance or which imposes additional requirements for effectiveness or validity.
3. That in accordance with Clayton Charter Section 4.031 the requirement that this enactment be read on two (2) separate days is complied with by readings on March 6, 2014 and March 20, 2014.
4. That in accordance with Clayton Charter Section 4.031(H) this enactment shall become effective thirty days after its second reading and enactment.
