ORDINANCE NO. O – 08 -14- 15

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CLAYTON CODIFIED ORDINANCE SECTION 1501.01 TO ADOPT THE MOST CURRENT EDITION OF THE OHIO FIRE CODE

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Clayton deems it necessary for the public health, safety and welfare of its constituents to amend its Codified Ordinances to provide for the adoption of the most current edition of the Ohio Fire Code.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLAYTON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. That Clayton Codified Ordinance Section 1501.01 is amended to read as follows (deletions are in ~~strike~~through and additions are in **bold**):

1501.01 ADOPTION.

There is hereby adopted by the Municipality, the ~~2011~~ **current edition of the** Ohio Fire Code (OFC) as adopted by the Ohio Division of State Fire Marshall, Department of Commerce, and as published in Division 1301:7 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC).

2. Two copies of said Code shall be retained in the office of the Clerk of Council or such designee officer as the Clerk may select and made available for public inspection upon request.

3. That this Ordinance shall be effective as an exception to any ordinance, resolution or other legislation of the City of Clayton, Ohio, inconsistent with this Ordinance or which imposes additional requirements for effectiveness or validity.

4. That in accordance with Clayton Charter Section 4.031 the requirement that this enactment be read on two (2) separate days is complied with by readings on August 7, 2014 and August 21, 2014.

5. That in accordance with Clayton Charter Section 4.031(H) this enactment shall become effective thirty days after its second reading and enactment.
