RESOLUTION NO. R – 10 – 14 - 69

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH ANTHEM BLUE CROSS BLUE SHIELD FOR THE PROVISION OF GROUP HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFITS FROM DECEMBER 1, 2014 THROUGH DECEMBER 1, 2015

WHEREAS, the City's insurance broker has confirmed that the use of a formal competitive bidding process and delay associated therewith would increase rather than decrease the cost to purchase the health insurance benefits from December 1, 2014 through December 1, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the group health insurance plan for December 1, 2014 through December 1, 2015 will be a Health Savings Account (HSA), the effect of which will be to reduce the premium for the City and the eligible City employees; and

WHEREAS, the Anthem HSA policy permits continuation of the health insurance plan at the best and lowest price reasonably possible; and

WHEREAS, the minimal prior notice and pending deadline for completion of said action mandates the taking of emergency action.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLAYTON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to accept the proposal of and enter into an agreement with Anthem Blue Cross Blue Shield for the provision of group health insurance benefits in the form of a Health Savings Account (HSA) from December 1, 2014 through December 1, 2015 without an increase in premium payments.
2. That this Resolution shall be effective as an exception to any ordinance, resolution or other legislation of the City of Clayton, Ohio, inconsistent with this Resolution or which imposes additional requirements for effectiveness or validity.
